Services

Access Counseling Center

One-stop mental health assessments for first-time, non-emergency clients. Walk-in assessment services available on a first come, first served basis. Outpatient counseling available in an individual, group or family setting. Located at Ruth Cooper Center campus.

Substance Abuse Outpatient Counseling

Treatment for individuals requiring weekly one-to-one counseling for substance abuse and/or co-occurring disorders. Weekly support groups also available. *Phone: (239) 791-1557*

Community-Based Programs

Case management for children and adults, in-home therapeutic services for children and adults, functional family therapy and diversion services for those involved in the criminal justice system and supported employment for adults.

Outpatient Medical Services

Residential Treatment

Drug Abuse Treatment & Education (DATE): 28-day residential treatment program based on the 12-step recovery model. Our holistic approach features therapy, relapse prevention, stress management and meditation. *Call (239) 275-3222 ext. 1060*

Rieves Residential: Brief residential treatment services for individuals diagnosed with schizophrenia or a mood disorder. *Call (239) 275-3222 ext. 1506* for further information and eligibility requirements.

Emergency Services

24-hour assessments of adults and children for emergency psychiatric symptoms. Baker Act and juvenile Marchman Act Receiving Facility for involuntary assessment. Referrals to appropriate inpatient or outpatient treatment programs.

Adult Crisis Stabilization Unit (CSU)

Secure, inpatient psychiatric stabilization for individuals who require the highest level of care and are at risk of harming themselves or others. 30-bed unit with an average stay of three (3) days.

Children's Crisis Stabilization Unit & Addiction Receiving Facility (CCSU/ARF)

Secure, inpatient psychiatric stabilization and substance abuse assessment for children ages 4 - 17. Family-based treatment. 10-bed unit with an average stay of three (3) days.
